1. A copy of government-issued identification (driver's license, military ID, passport, etc.).

2. A completed Volunteer Application Form (located at http://www.littleleague.org/assets/forms_pubs/VolunteerApp15.pdf).

Complete this form and mail it to the address below, or bring it to an upcoming walk-in registration or clinic.

3. Concussion Awareness Certification (located at <http://www.cdc.gov/concussion/HeadsUp/Training/index.html>).

Go to the link listed above to access the Center for Disease Control's online "Head's Up" Concussion training. Complete this training, print your certificate, and mail it to the address below or bring it to an upcoming walk-in registration or clinic.
